

HOW TO TRACK YOUR VOTE-BY-MAIL BALLOT

Follow these steps to track your mail ballot and make sure your vote counts!

If your mail ballot is rejected because your signature is missing on the return envelope or it does not match the signature on file with the Supervisor of Elections (SOE) office, you can mail, fax, email or hand-deliver a signed affidavit to your SOE office, along with a copy of an accepted form of identification.

1. Track your ballot at:

2. Contact your Supervisor of Elections office

If you can't track your ballot on the website within 3 days of mailing your vote by mail ballot, you should contact the SOE office to confirm that your ballot was received.

3. If your mail ballot was rejected

If you find out your vote by mail signature was not accepted, the SOE office is required by law to tell you exactly why. The signature may be missing or the signature is considered to not match the signature on file with the SOE office.

4. You have the right to remedy your ballot

If your mail ballot is rejected for a missing or mismatched signature, your SOE office must give you the chance to remedy or "cure" the problem.

5. You have the right to update your signature

In addition to being told the reason why your mail ballot was rejected and being given the chance to remedy the problem, you also can update your current signature on record using your "cure" affidavit.
